


MAKING A BOW

1: Make a loop in the ribbon, ensuring the end overlaps the centre point by 2-3cm. Then create more loops by wrapping the ribbon around 5-6 times. Winding it round a copy of *Pure Peak* works well!



3: Cut off the ribbon – taking care to overlap the centre by 2-3cm again – then slip it off your guide and hold firmly.

4: Fold bundle in half, taking care not to drop the two ends. Snip off the corners of fold, leaving a third of the width in the middle and creating a curved notch each side.



5: Open out carefully and tie a piece of ribbon firmly around the centre, gathering it as you knot. (A length of ribbon pulls easily into six narrow strips for this.)



6: Separate the loops at one end, pulling them out from alternate sides of the bundle and twisting as you go. Repeat with the other end, then arrange to form a bow.



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
